Prerequisite:

Entrance Exam \$100.00 (Note: THIS FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE)

Test of Basic Education skills in Reading, Math, Biology, and Critical Thinking (HESI)

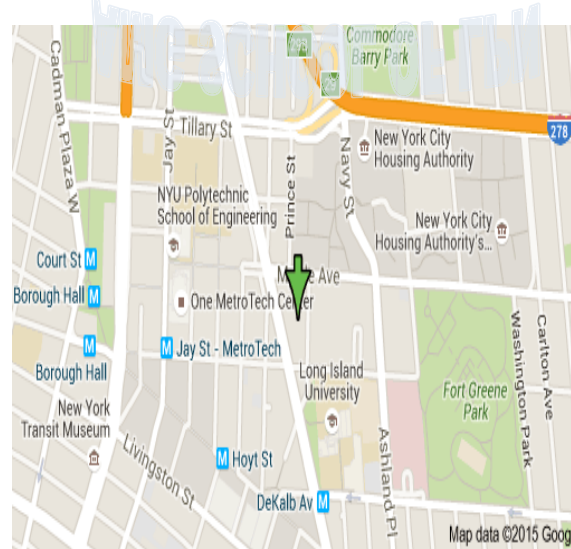
Passing Scores: Reading– 80%
Math– 70%
Biology– 70%
Critical Thinking– 850

If any portion of the entrance exam is failed the cost is \$100 to re-test.

An application and interview is required once the Entrance Exam has been successfully completed.

A. Applicants must present two forms of ID which include:

Valid Driver License of Non- Driver license

Social Security Card and or Birth Certificate

If Non-Citizen- Alien Registration Card or Employment Authorization Card Valid for Term of School Enrollment.

If Naturalized Citizen- Original Naturalization Paper/or U.S. Passport.

B. Original High School Diploma or Original Equivalency Certificate (GED) with Scores.

An Official Transcript must provided along with the Diploma.
